Degree Programme (5½ years) for the Academic Session: 2020-2021 under the Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, W.B.U.A.F.S., Mohanpur campus, Nadia, West Bengal through University website (<http://www.wbuafsce.org>).

Eligibility Criteria for Admission in U.G.-B.V.Sc. & A.H. Course (2020-2021) :

1. Citizenship: The Applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. Age- Not less than 17 years and not more than 25 years as on or before 31st December of that year of admission. There shall be a relaxation of the upper age limit by maximum 5 (five) years for SC/ST/OBC-A & OBC-B candidates.
3. The candidate must qualify and obtain a rank in the NEET-UG-2020 conducted by NTA.
4. The candidate must be a domicile of West Bengal.
5. The candidate must pass Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination of the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination in science stream from any recognized Board/ Council from any institution within West Bengal.
6. The candidate must pass the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examinations from any recognized Board/ Council with Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology and English as compulsory subjects with individual pass marks (in both theory and practical wherever applicable) in all the above four subjects in regular class mode.
7. The candidate must obtain 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology and English taken together for unreserved category and 47.5 % in case of reserved category candidates.
8. Students of the Open schooling are not eligible for the course.

Eligibility Criteria for PwD Category Candidates-

(I) A candidate shall not be allowed admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course if he/ she suffers the following disabilities, namely—

- (a) disability of total body including disability of chest or spine more than 50%,
- (b) disability of lower limb of more than 50%,
- (c) disability of upper limb,
- (d) visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability,
- (e) candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- (f) disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

(II) The disability shall be certified by a duly constituted and Government authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two shall be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him or her-self before the Medical Board and the last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board shall not be more than three months old from the date of submitting his or her certificate for disabled candidates.

After publication of Provisional Merit List of B.V.Sc. & A.H. Admission (2020-2021) on 02.12.2020, the valid and interested rank holders may participate in the counseling process by registering themselves online through University website (www.wbuafsc.org) as per the date(s) notified for the purpose. **Candidates must have to register themselves to participate in the said online counselling cum admission process.** Online Application/ Registration does not ensure a candidate got admission.

Candidates will have to upload the scanned copies (**colour**) of their original documents as follows in JPG/PDF format during online application. Failing to this the candidate will not be considered for admission:

4. The Medical Certificate and Declaration on Ragging must be given along with the application form in prescribed format at the time of admission.

6. Only submission of online application does not constitute a right for admission and the decision of the admission committee is full and final.
