Candidates will have to bring the following testimonials along with originals for verification at the time of physical reporting and admission failing which the candidate will not be considered for admission:

- One recent Passport size Colour Photo,
- Printed hardcopy of online filled in Application Form,
- Hall Ticket for Counselling.
- Original Medical Fitness Certificate,
- Self attested photocopy of Secondary Examination Admit Card/ Birth Certificate as age proof,
- Self attested photocopy of Mark sheet of Secondary Examination,
- Self attested photocopy of Mark sheet of Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination,
- Self attested photocopy of SC/ST/OBC-A/ OBC-B/PwD Certificate (wherever applicable),
- Self attested photocopy of Domicile Certificate,
- Declaration against Ragging (Proforma to be downloaded from website).

The Admission fee of Rs. 9,860/- for General, SC, ST, OBC-A & OBC-B (Day scholar) candidates has to be deposited on the day of admission by cash through Bank-challan at Belgachia branch only of Union Bank of India located at University Campus. [\*Service charge and Applicable tax are extra].

All the candidates are to be admitted as Day scholar only and hostels will be given on application to be determined by the Office of the DSW/ISW.

The venue for Counselling, Physical Reporting and Admission will be at the Examination hall under the Office of the Controller of Examinations, WBUAFS, Vivek Bhawan, 68, K. B. Sarani, Belgachia, Kolkata – 700 037, West Bengal (Nearest location- Belgachia Metro Station, Google map location- Click here to locate).

Only candidates are eligible to enter into the Counselling venue for Physical Reporting and Admission on presenting the "Hall Ticket for Counselling". Names of the candidates will be announced during counselling and they must be very careful as it will be announced once only. Candidates reporting after stipulated time as mentioned in the notice will not be entertained.

The Provisional Seat Allotment will be made serially from the Provisional list of Registered Candidates till filling up of the available seats from the respective categories. **Candidates who fail to attend Counselling on the notified date and time shall forfeit their claim for admission and participation in further rounds of Counselling (if any).** Calling to attend for Counselling on the notified date does not mean the provisional allotment of a seat to a candidate. All the admission will be purely provisional and is liable to be cancelled at any stage of counselling process and even after the admission, in case any irregularity/ inconsistency in document is noticed. Decision of the University in all matters related to admission will be final and binding on the candidates.

This is for information to the **GTA nominated candidates** that the above admission schedule is also applicable for them.

## <u>Important Instructions for the Candidates for physical reporting to protect themselves and others from COVID-19:</u>

- Candidates need to maintain at least a six feet distance between themselves and others as per the social distancing norms during physical reporting.
- Candidates will have to wear a mask/ face cover.
- Candidates will be required to sanitize hands with Hand Sanitizer before entry in the University campus.
